- Overview of treating fractures and head injuries.
- Group discussions on potential scenarios and their responses.

Day 5: Emergency Preparedness in Marine Settings

- Adapting BLS knowledge to real-life marine conditions.
- Overview of maritime safety protocols and regulations.
- Case studies focusing on marine-specific emergencies.
- Final review and knowledge assessment.
